The MPH in Global Health concentration is designed for students and professionals interested in global health practice or working in various roles in population-based health for health promotion, disease prevention and control including program implementation, monitoring, and evaluation; and health program entrepreneurship. The concentration is designed to respond to the unique workforce needs across different regions of the world. The program builds on the core public health foundational sciences and competencies from epidemiology, social and behavioral sciences, health policy, environmental health, and biostatistics, and a suite of required courses relevant to global health practice, program implementation, monitoring and evaluation, leadership, and communication for sustainable development.

and international public health systems to deliver public health services to meet the needs

Integrity/Values

 Apply leadership principles in collaboration with other stakeholders in inter-professional teams to develop policies and/or programs to positively influence health outcomes and equity in low-and-middle income countries.

Project Management

Develop population-based public health policies, programs, projects or interventions
utilizing budgetary tools and resource management while incorporating knowledge of
public health organizations and systems.

Assessment of Student Learning Outcomes

Graduate students in the Master of Public Health in Global Health concentration will acquire advanced skills and competencies for innovative, ethical and competent leadership in a dynamic global health profession with increasing workforce needs. Direct assessment in this program is conducted using examinations, case-study analysis that incorporate public health principles, theories and concepts to problem-solving. The Practicum in Public Health courses integrate content from the didactic courses. Indirect assessment practices in this program include a comprehensive exit exam.
