- The <u>Food Assistance Program</u> helps individuals and families purchase nutritional foods needed to maintain and promote good health.
- The <u>Temporary Cash Assistance</u> program provides financial assistance to pregnant women in their third trimester and families with dependent children to assist in the payment of rent, utilities and other household expenses.
- The <u>Medicaid Program</u> provides medical assistance to individuals and families to cover or assist in the cost of services that are medically necessary.
