Chapter 300: The Senate

308.2 Submission of Legislation

- A. With the exception of the A&S Fee Budget bill, all legislation must be submitted to the Rules & Statutes Committee at least seven business days prior to the Senate meeting at which said legislation is to be considered.
- B. All approved legislation must be presented to the Senate President at least forty-eight hours prior to the Senate meeting at which said legislation is to be considered. All legislation will be made available to all Senate members for review twenty-four hours prior to the scheduled Senate meeting.
- C. The Senate President must post a current projected agenda for each Senate meeting. The agenda shall be posted on the wall outside the Student Government office. All bills, resolutions, and recommendations shall include the number of each piece of legislation, its author(s), and a brief summary of its content. All appointments and nominations for all Student Government Association offices shall include the name of the appointee/ nominee and the position to which they aspire. This agenda must be posted at least twenty four hours prior to the meeting which it outlines, and it must be updated regularly to include all submitted agenda items.
- D. Legislation which is not submitted to the Senate President at least fortyeight hours prior to the meeting at which it is to be considered will be placed on the agenda only by a two-thirds vote of the Senate.
- E. Each legislative action will require the signature of at least 2 Student Government Senators as sponsors and the signature of the author of said legislation, to be placed on the agenda and heard in a Student Government meeting.
