Apologizes for lateness, due to a meeting. Football and issues of our facilities. Plan is to build both practice and game field. More funds were expected from the state based on student credit hours. Students jrs and srs are taking fewer hours. Students are taking fewer courses and working more instead on relying on financial aid. Deciding to wait a year or less to build a new budget that fits our finances. Competition field will be built first, then practice field. There will be a greater emphasis in collecting funds. Hoping to generate more private funds.
Number 3 on the state's priority list of new buildings, building 58 . New labs will be coming along with offices and administration. Academic facilities much more expensive than football construction. UWF earns back 2 million dollars, put together an improvement plan and accomplished it so half of the money was sent back. Good news with Metric 21 out of 50 became 37 out of 50 . Excess hours metric is being recalculated because it was done wrong. Improved 9 out of 10 on the metric. Hopefully we will get more money (millions).
