Each year, 10 to 15 percent of New College's enrollment is comprised of students who transfer from other institutions. Our 7:1 student-to-faculty ratio provides an intimate academic environment, where students are involved in designing their own curriculum. Our waterfront location on Sarasota Bay and year-round warm temperatures are equally enticing.

## What makes New College of Florida unique?

All honors. As the state of Florida's designated honors college, New College accepts only top-performing students.

**40+ undergraduate concentrations across the sciences, social sciences and humanities**. Professors teach research and analysis methods, and students apply these skills to a senior capstone project. We also have an exceptional master's degree program in Applied Data Science.

**Flexibility**. Students customize their programs with internships and projects for academic credit. Faculty know their students, and write performance evaluations that focus on individual performance.

**Personalized academic and career coaching.** All students are assigned one faculty adviser who will guide, coach and mentor them through their area of study from day one through graduation. Plus, all new students are assigned a career coach to build their planning, networking and communication skills.

#### **Transfer Eligibility**

- Transfers are expected to have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.6.
- Transfers must be in good standing and eligible to return to their last postsecondary institution as a degree-seeking student.

#### **Application Requirements**

- New College Application (no application fee) or Common Application
- Official transcripts: one for each school attended, high school through college, and GED if applicable
- SAT or ACT scores, or 30+ transferable credit hours

#### Housing

On-campus housing is available and highly encouraged for all transfer students for the entirety of the New College experience.

### **Transfer Eligibility**

 Transfer credit is assigned toward New College's semester contract, Independent Study Project (ISP) and unit requirements for the bachelor of arts degree.

Credit is considered for arts and sciences college courses with grades of a C or better.

Students who already hold 1) Florida College System or Florida State University System associate of arts degree or 2) a bachelor's or advanced degree from a regionally accredited college or university, would earn maximum transfer credit:

- 3 semester contracts (out of 7 required)
- 1 Independent Study Project (out of 3 required)
- 15 units (unit equivalent to 60 credit hours, out of 31 units required)
- For all other students, transfer credit is based on 16 or more transferable semester credit hours, as follows:
  - 16-19 transferable semester hours = 4 units, 1 semester contract
  - 20-35 transferable semester hours = 5 units, 1 semester contract, 1 ISP
  - 36-51 transferable semester hours = 9 units, 2 semester contracts, 1 ISP
  - 52+ transferable semester hours = 13 units, 3 semester contracts, 1 ISP
- In no case may transfer credit be given for more than 3 contracts and 1 Independent Study Project.
  Every New College student must complete at least 4 contracts and 2 Independent Study Projects in residence at New College in order to graduate.
