HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1

Complete and submit our institutional application at *unf.edu/apply*.

STEP 2

Pay the nonrefundable \$30 application fee online or upload a copy of your application fee waiver, if eligible, through your applicant portal.

STEP 3

Send your college transcripts from every institution you have attended to UNF, including any AP, IB, AICE or dual enrollment college transcripts.

STEP 4*

Submit your official high school transcript.

STEP 5*

Upload a PDF copy of your SAT, ACT and/or CLT test scores through your applicant portal or send directly from the College Board (UNF code: 5490), ACT (UNF code: 0711) or CLT website.

*Upper level transfer applicants are not required to submit an official high school transcript or test scores.
