Through group interactions, participants will engage in discussions and devise strategic responses to potential cybersecurity attacks. Emphasis will be placed on identifying attack indicators and formulating proactive measures to prevent and counteract them. The session will conclude with an insightful exploration of real-world case studies involving cybersecurity incidents. This portion will delve into the responses of the affected organizations and extract valuable lessons learned from each incident.
