

Switching Concentration

Students may change concentrations (e.g., changing from Counseling to Applied Experimental). In order to change, students must:

1. Meet with the program coordinators of both tracks.
2. Submit a new letter of intent describing their career goals and how the track will help them in their pursuit of these goals.

Students will be re-evaluated for the new track based on their current class performance and new letter of intent. Students who receive approval to switch tracks must meet with an advisor from the new track to review degree requirements. Students may apply for a track change only once.

Students should request that each program coordinator sign their letter of intent to indicate approval for changing tracks. Once both track coordinators' signatures are obtained, the form should be brought to the Departmental Coordinator for processing.
