REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: UWF REGULATION 4.008 – *Tuition and Fees, Fines and Penalties*.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of this amendment is to replace the dollar amount of the "Third Time Repeat Fee" with language that explains that this fee is set annually by the Board of Governors.

SUMMARY: The proposed amendment to this regulation is as follows:

4) Other Fees

• Amended to replace the dollar amount for the "Third Time Repeat Fee" with "Established by BOG."
