REGULATION TITLE: **Tuition and Fees, Fines and Penalties (Fall 2005)**

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of the proposed regulation is to reflect the amount of tuition, fees, fines and penalties at the University.

SUMMARY: Establishes tuition rates, fees, fines and penalties.

**Tuition Rates, Fees, Fines, and Penalties (Fall 2005).**
