THE UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION AMENDMENT

REGULATION TITLE: *UWF/REG* – 4.008 Tuition and Fees, Fines and Penalties

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of the regulation is to reflect the amount of tuition, fees, fines and penalties at the University for the 2014-2015 Academic Year.

SUMMARY: The proposed amendment reflects the following:

Section 1) Tuition: An increase in the Graduate Basic Tuition Fee of \$4.36 per credit hour. The tuition category for the MSN courses and Emerald Coast Ed.D. cohort courses was changed to show the amount of the Tuition Differential instead of the total amount of the Graduate Basic Tuition Fee and the Tuition Differential.

Section 2) Mandatory Fees: An increase in the amount of the graduate financial aid fee in the amount of .22 per credit hour, which is calculated at 5% of the basic graduate tuition. The Health, Athletic and Activity and Service fees in the aggregate were increased .11 per credit hour. Clarification of the description of the Technology fee is "up to 5% of applicable basic tuition," because that is the maximum authority granted by the BOG for this fee.

Section 3) Market Rate Tuition: This section was added to reflect the establishment of four new graduate programs authorized by the Board of Governors to be offered by Continuing Education at market tuition rates. These programs are the M.Ed., in Educational Leadership, the M.Ed., in Reading Program, the Ed.D., in Curriculum & Instruction: Curriculum Studies specialization and the M.Acc. Master of Accountancy. All but the Master of Accountancy will begin in the Fall, 2014.

Section 4) Other Fees: The third time repeat fee, which is set by the Board of Governors, was changed by the Board of Governors from \$122.00 to \$158.84
