DATE: July 3, 2019

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: *UWF/REG – 4.008 Tuition and Fees, Fines and Penalties*

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: UWF Regulation 4.008 is being amended to reflect a rate increase to the excess hour fee set by the Florida Legislature.

SUMMARY: The proposed changes to this regulation provide the following:

- Proposed changes will be applicable to students who entered a postsecondary undergraduate program at any institution of higher education for the first time in summer 2019.
- New language added regarding an update to the excess hour surcharge which now applies to credit hours in excess of 120 percent of the number of credit hours required to complete the baccalaureate degree program in which a student is enrolled.
- Percent change is increasing from "110% of the number of credit hours required to complete the baccalaureate degree" to "120% of the number of credit hours required to complete the baccalaureate degree".

AUTHORITY TO AMEND THE REGULATION: Article IX of the Florida Constitution; Florida Board of Governors Regulations 1.001 and 7.001.
