THE UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION AMENDMENT (Revised)

REGULATION TITLE: UWF/REG – 4.008 Tuition Rates, Fees, Fines and Penalties (Fall 2013)

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose and effect of the regulation is to reflect the amount of tuition, fees, fines and penalties at the University for the 2013-2014 Academic Year.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS: The proposed amendment reflects an undergraduate tuition increase of 1.7% mandated by section 1009.24(4)(b), F.S. which equates to an increase from \$103.32 to \$105.07 per credit hour. The amendment also shows a corresponding 5% increase in the Financial Aid fee and in the Technology fee. A \$16.47 per credit hour increase is proposed for both the graduate basic tuition and the graduate tuition for cohort courses. This equates to increases of 6% and 5.2% respectively. The amendment also shows a corresponding 5% increase in the Financial Aid fee and in the Technology fee for graduate students as well.

A \$2.00 increase in the CITF fee for all students is proposed, which is subject to approval by the Board of Governors.* Also reflected in the amendments is a combined increase of \$1.99 per credit hour in the Health, Athletic and Activity and Service fees, which was approved by the UWF Board of Trustees at its December 14, 2012 meeting. Board of Governors increases in the Excess Hour fee (1.7%), and the Third Time Repeat fee (\$1.76) are also reflected in the amendment.
