HISTORY



1964 - July: Dr. Harold Crosby assumes office as the first UWF president, oversees the establishment of the UWF Fort Walton Beach Center - housed on Eglin AFB, serving military and civilian students.

1983 - August: UWF and Okaloosa Walton Community College, now Northwest Florida State College, open a joint-education facility at the former Oakland Heights Elementary School.



1992 - August: UWF and Okaloosa Walton Community College, now Northwest Florida State College, build and open a new joint location where the two institutions administer their programs.

2006 - UWF Fort Walton Beach Center renamed to UWF Emerald Coast campus.


