




UNIVERSITY of WEST FLORIDA Metric 4 Progress

- Governs the collection, use, storage, and transfer of personal data
- Applies to anyone residing in a European
 Union state and/or travelling in a EU state as a
 UWF student or employee for academic or
 business purpose
- Effective May 25, 2018


