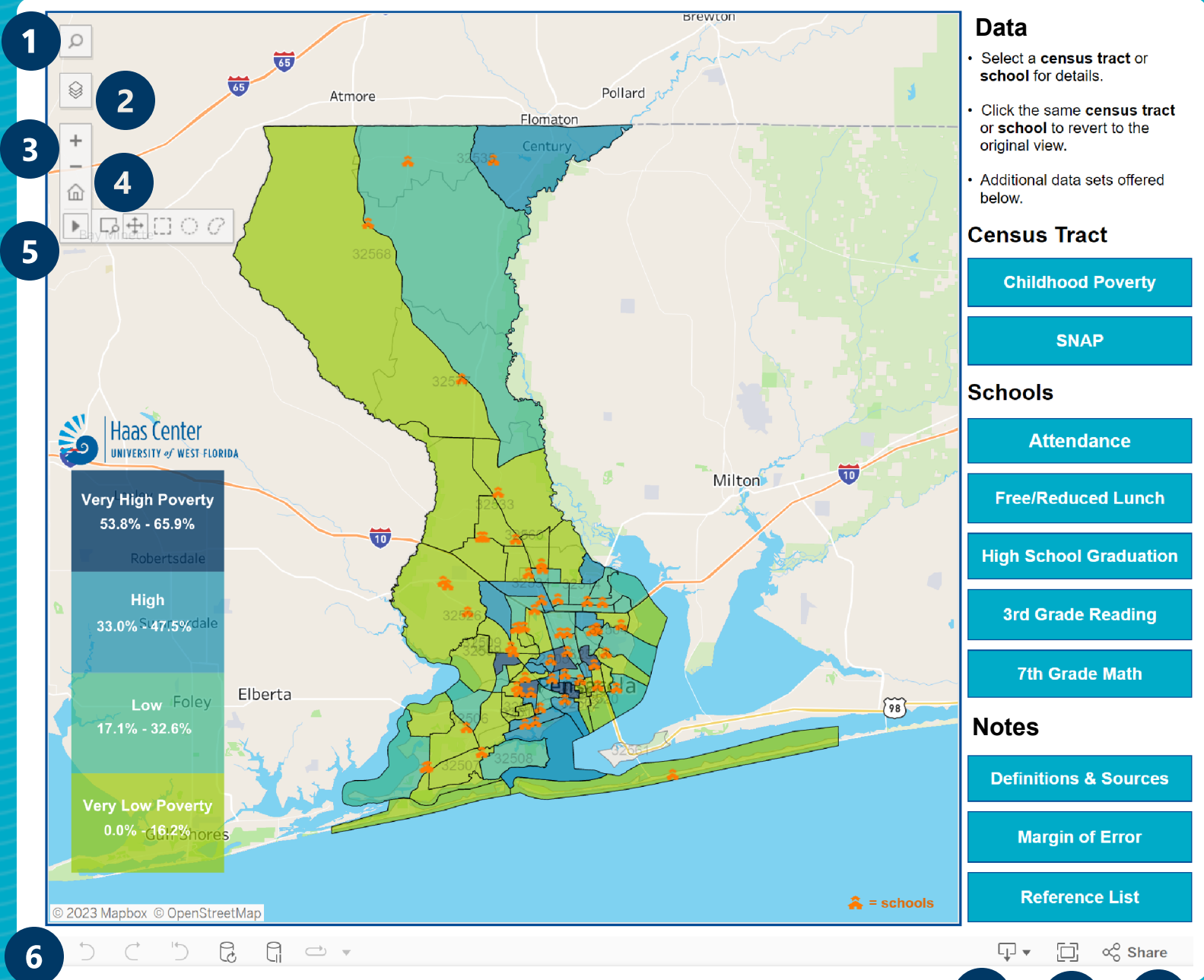


Pockets of Poverty: Navigating the Map

- 1. Search** - Use the search bar to find a specific zip code
- 2. Layer Control** - Use the control map layers to create a map view that you desire.
 - the School XY option will remove the school locations from the map when deselected.
 - the second option will remove the census tract borders and measures when deselected.
 - the ZIP option will remove the Zip code borders from the map when deselected.
- 3. Zoom** - Zoom in and out with the plus and minus functions.
- 4. Home** - Use the house button to reset the zoom to default.
- 5. Map Options** - Hovering over the arrow will reveal five ways to interact with the map:
 - zoom area which allows the user to zoom in on a specific area of the map.
 - pan which allows the user to move around the map.
 - rectangle which allows the user to highlight specific areas of the map in a rectangular shape.
 - radial allows the user to form a circle that shows the radius in miles from the center and highlight specific areas of the map.
 - lasso which allows the user to select different areas on the map.
- 6. Undo** - Use the reset view button to undo all changes.
- 7. Download** - Use the choose format to download to select how to download the graphic.
- 8. Full Screen** - Select this option to view the graphic in full screen.
- 9. Share** - Use the share view to either copy a link to the graphic or to copy the embed code.
