The Passio GO app is available on the Apple App Store and the Google Play Store for free.

The app offers vehicle tracking, real time information, route & stop details, messaging, and more.

The agency page is branded specifically to our client.

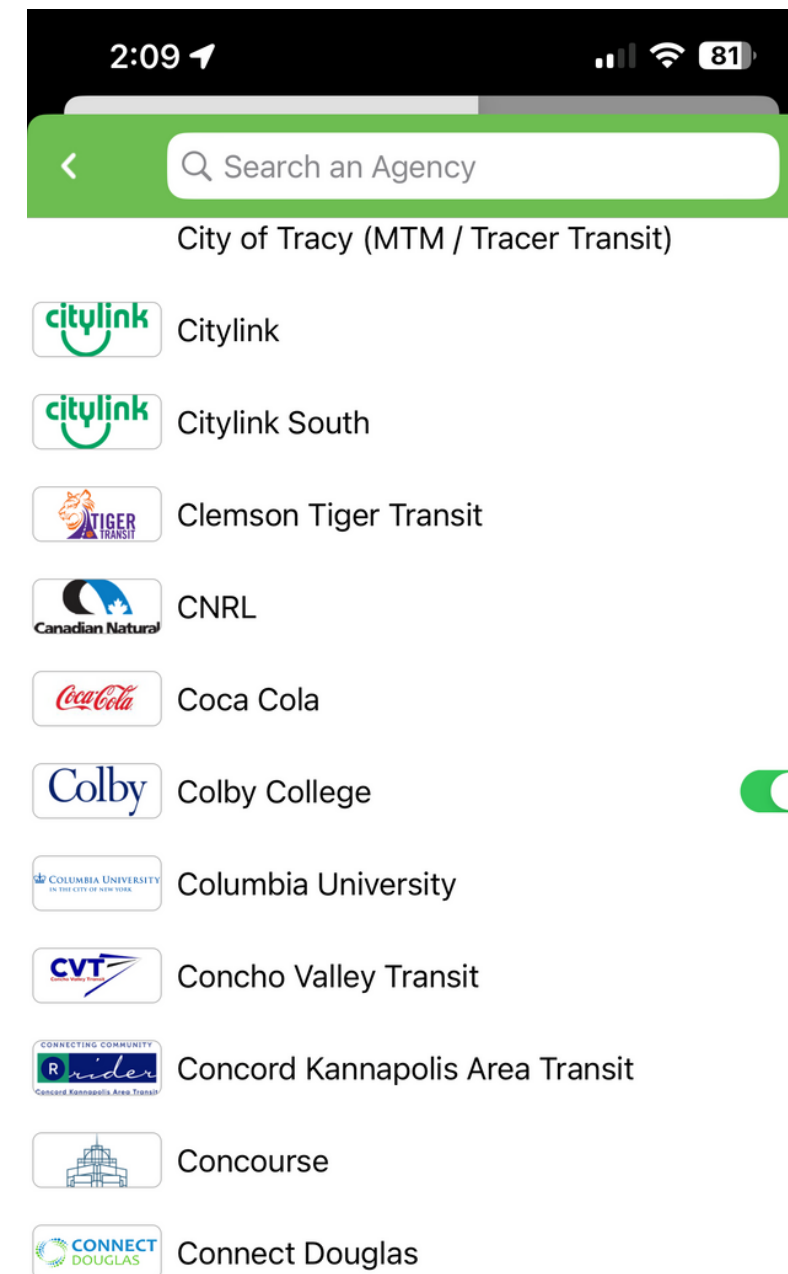

Passio GO Basics

- Riders simply use their iPhone or Android devices to download the free Passio GO app, where they will choose their agency (or agencies) that they want to view.
- This information can also be viewed online at passiogo.com if a rider doesn't wish to download the app.
- Passio GO opens to a tour of the app, which users can re-take at any time if they need to. Agencies that are closest to the rider's current location are listed first, making it easy for a passenger to find the right schedules and routes.



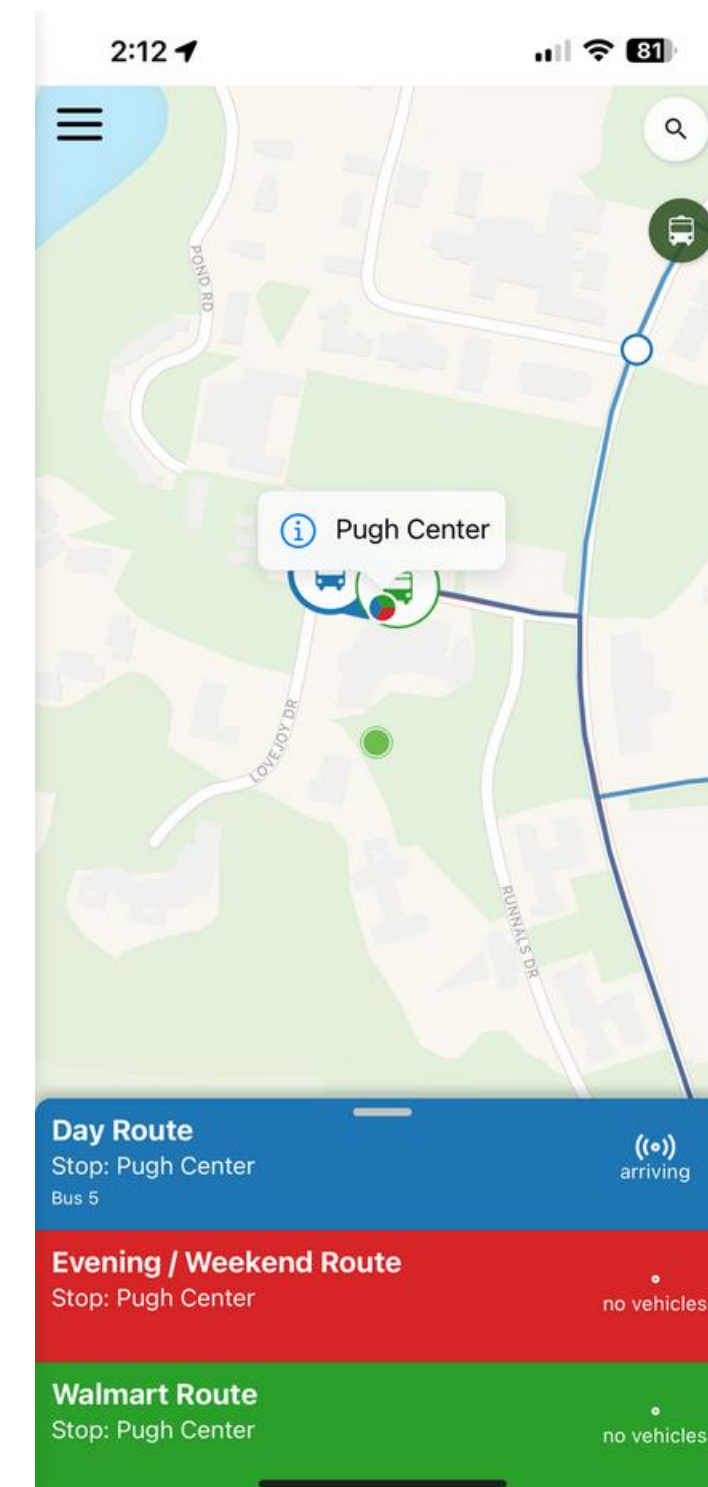
Passio GO Basics

Interactive Home Screen

- Maps, Routes, Agency Messages
- ETAs (Estimated Time of Arrivals), Schedules, and more in real-time
- BusBuzz (Feedback to transit agency) text or via app

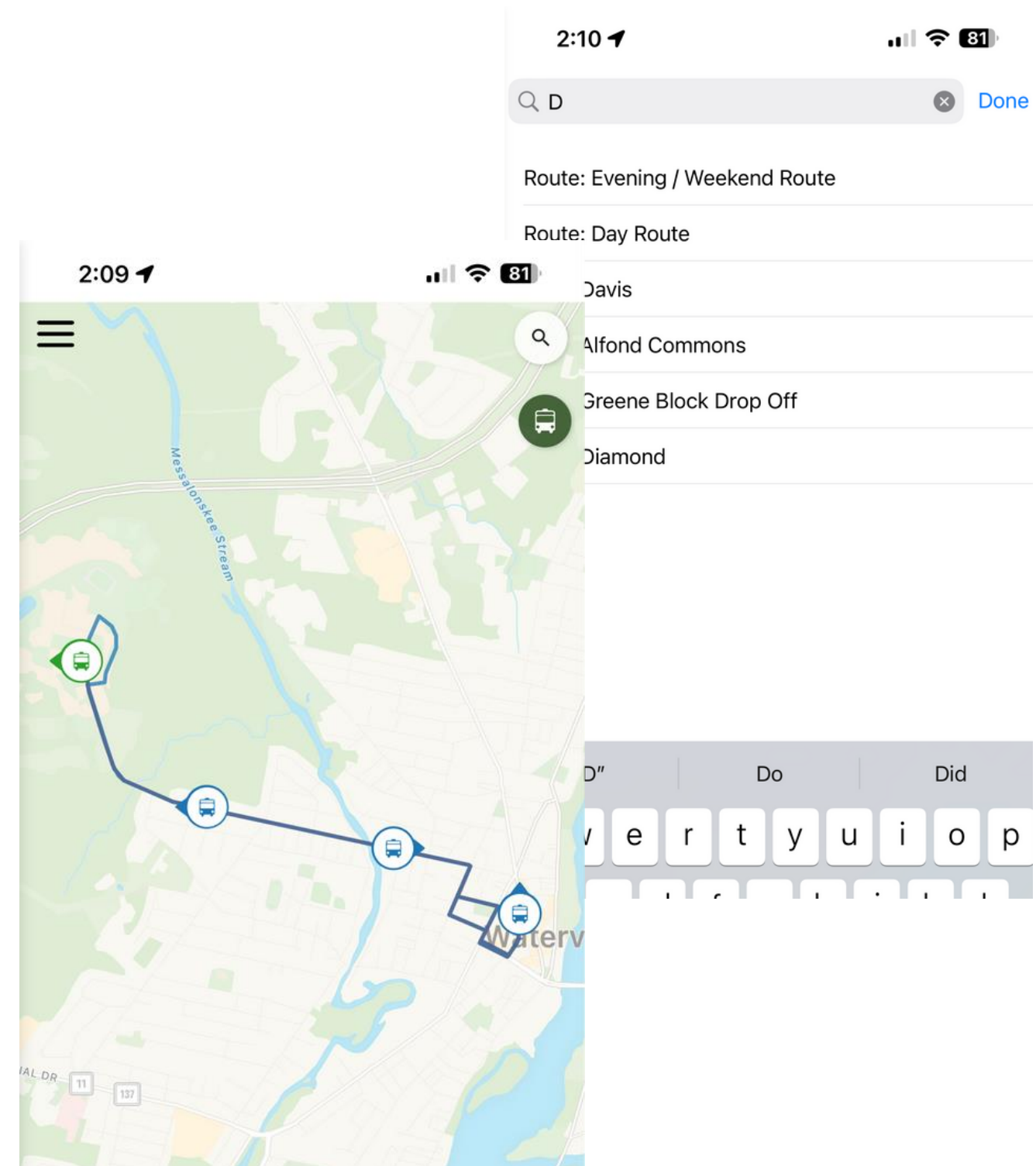
- "Tap to Set" Trip Start & Destination

Passio GO Basics

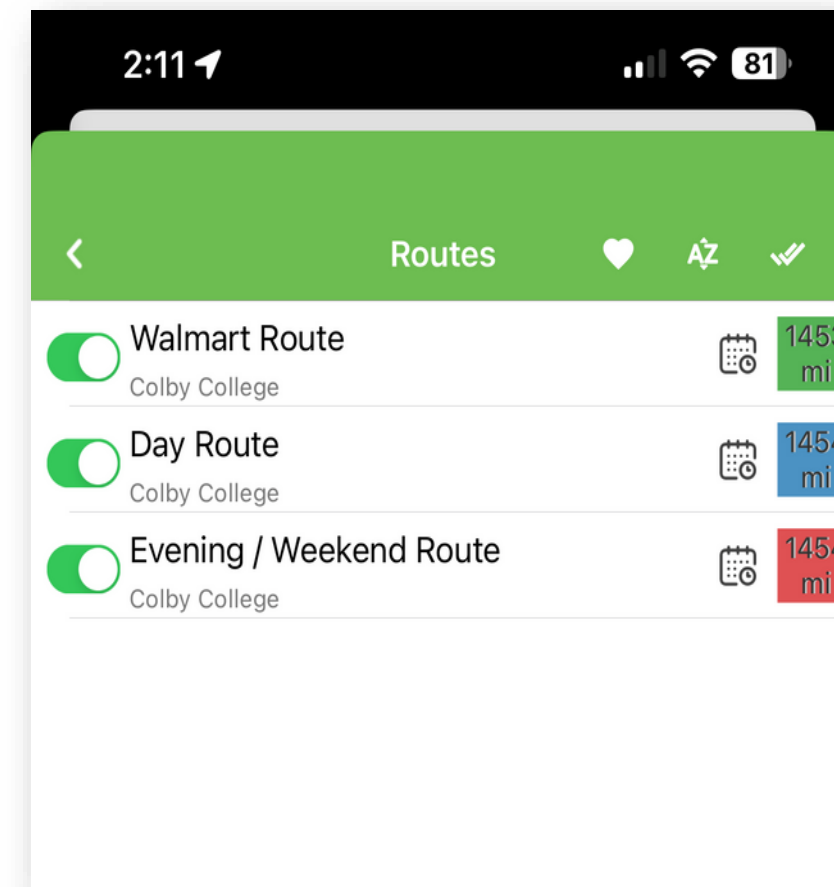
Riders can see routes, stops, schedules, and more using the app. They can even set up alerts to see when a vehicle is coming to their stop. There are multiple features within the app, such as a favorite button, to personalize each passenger experience.

Riders should keep an eye out for other features while taking the tour of the app, including the ability to search for the name of a route or stop, using the magnifying glass at the top of the home screen.



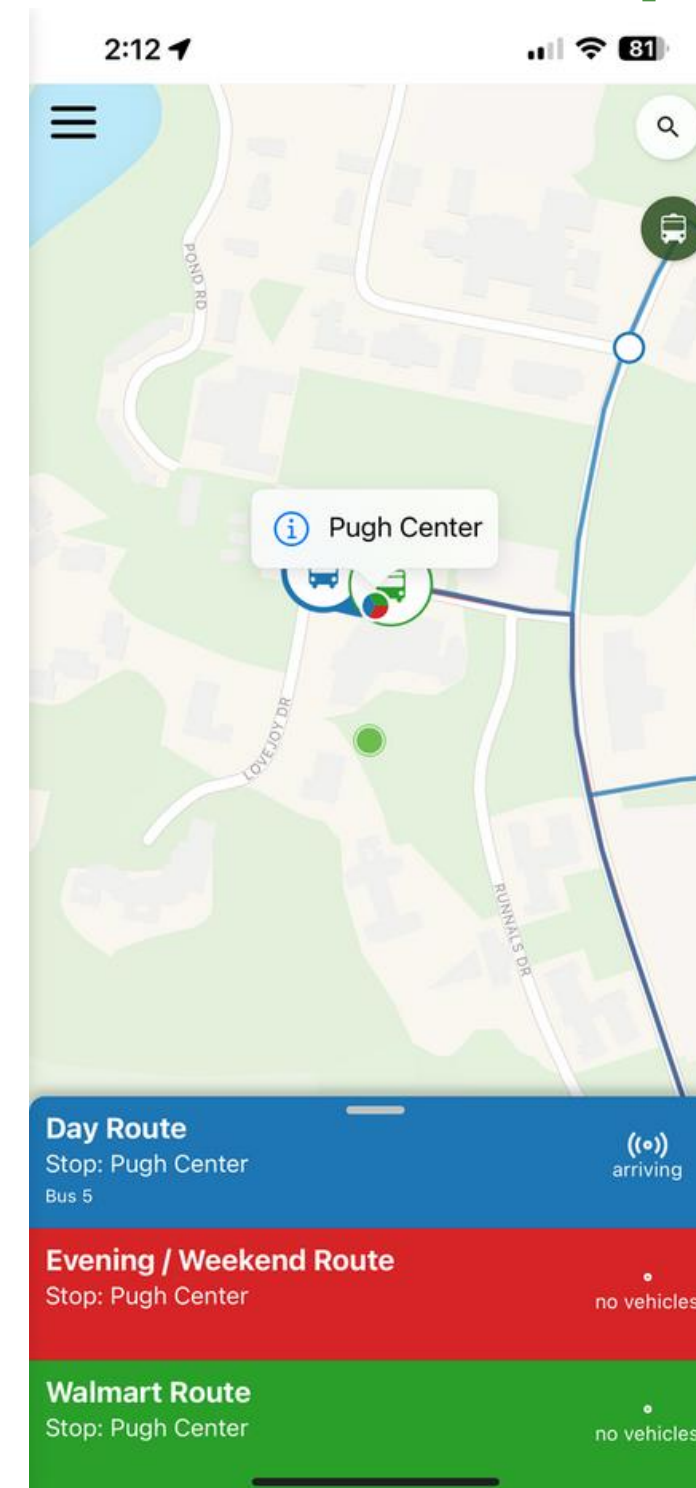
Rider View of Passio GO

- User friendly

- Set up alerts



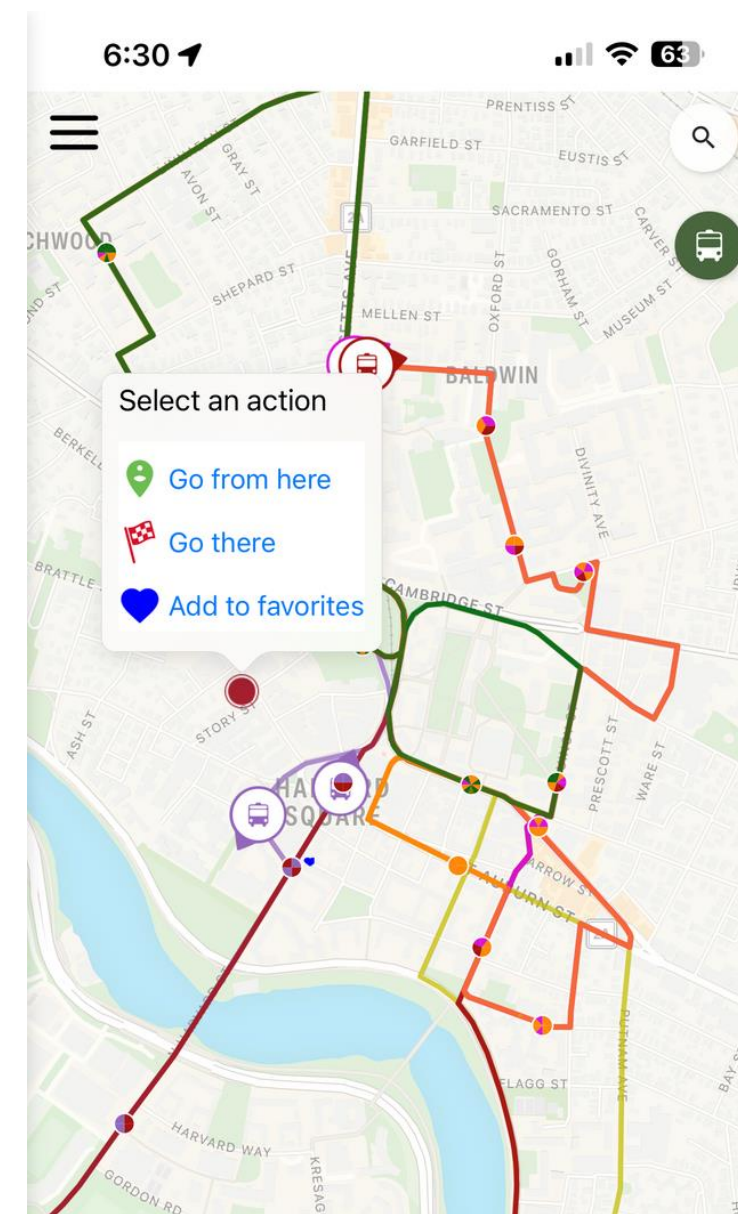
Interacting with the App

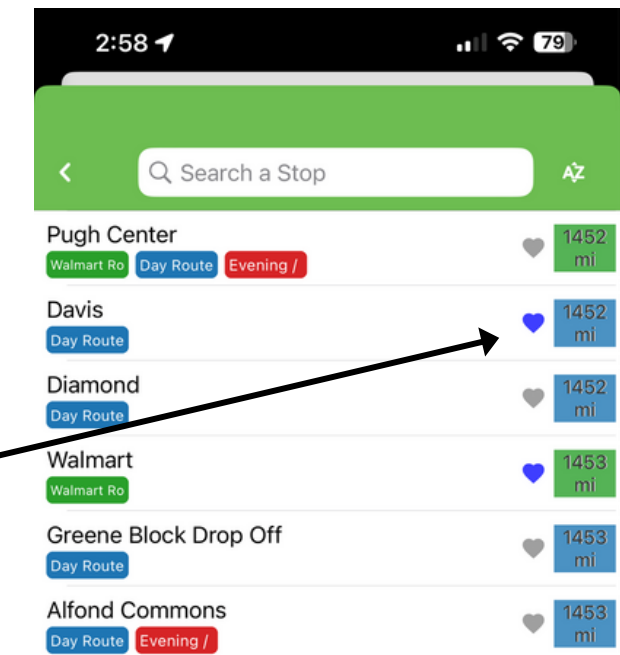
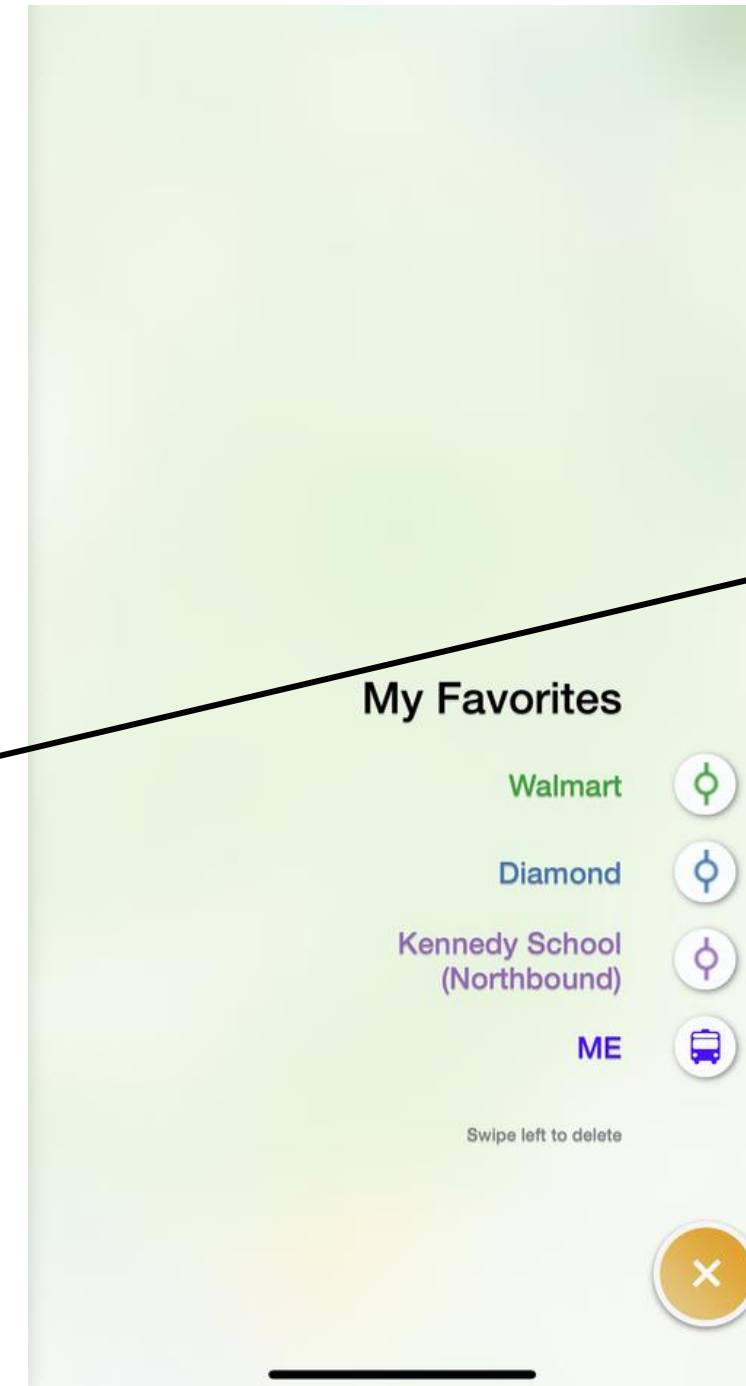
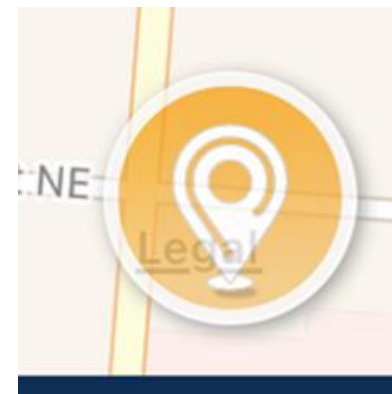

Favorites

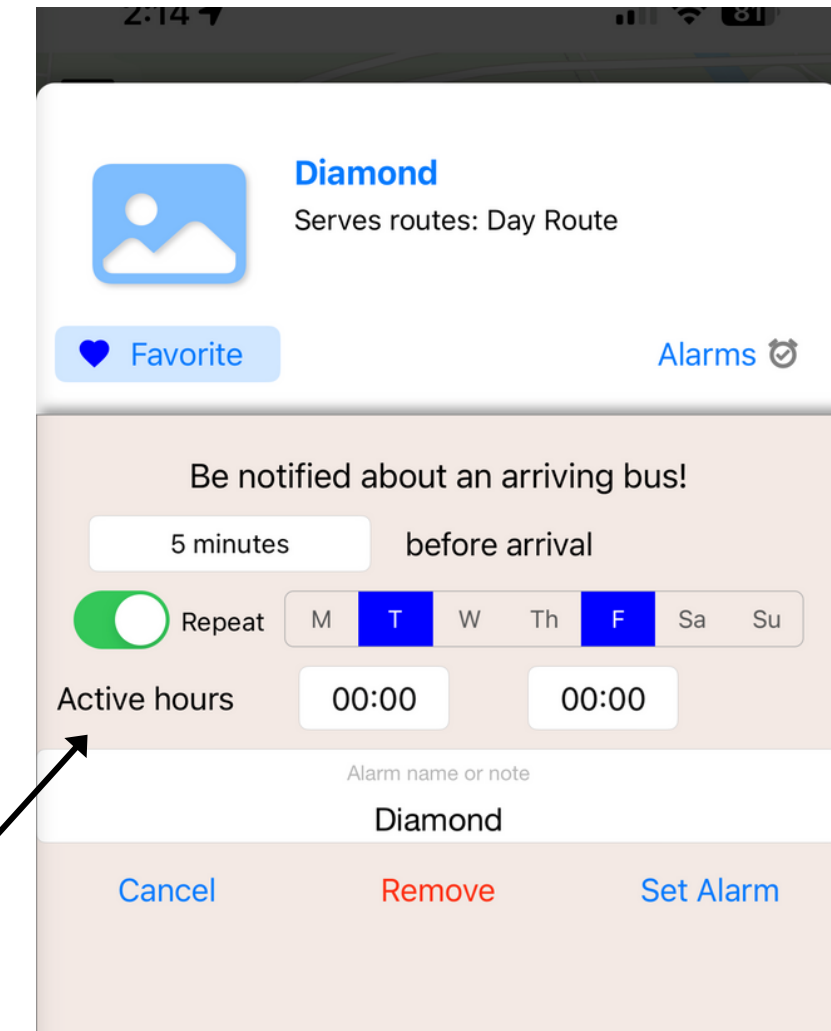
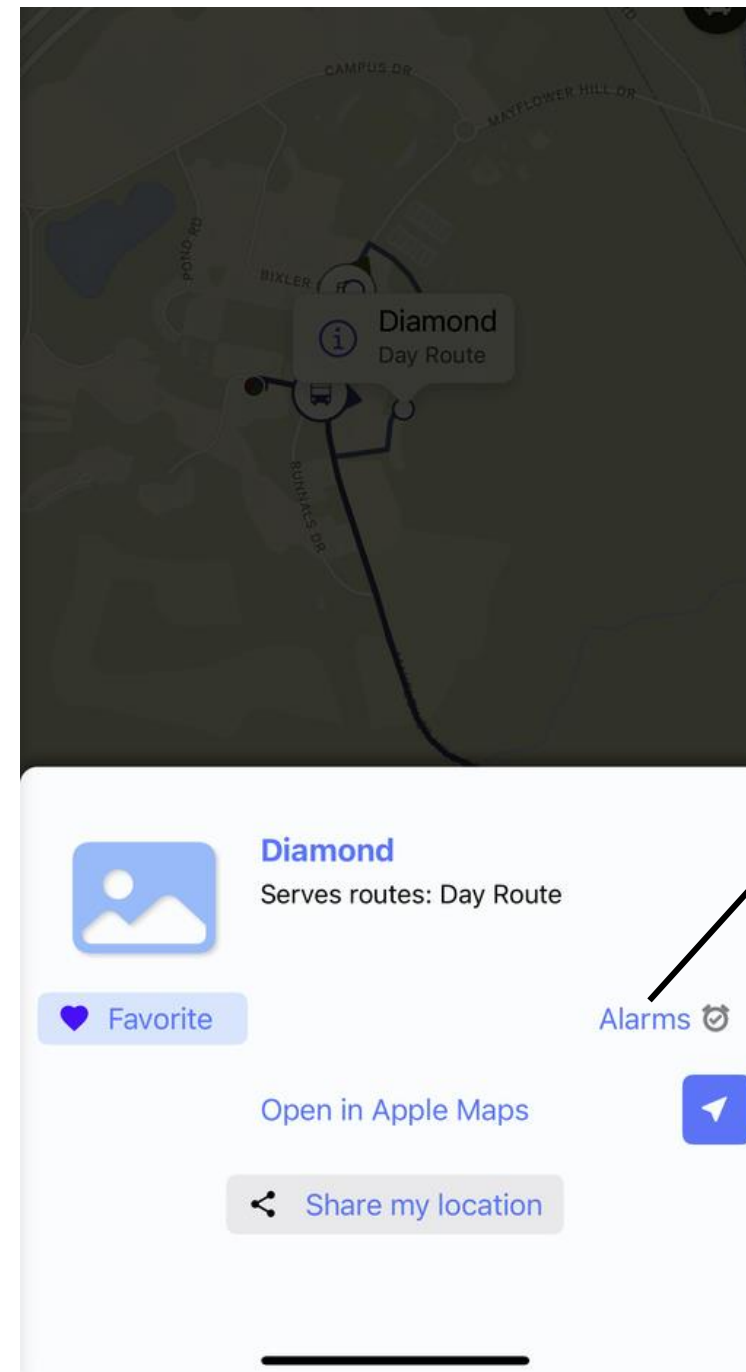
From the home screen, choose the Passio Icon to view your favorites

You can toggle between stops and routes on the bottom to add new favorites. The heart will turn blue after choosing that item.



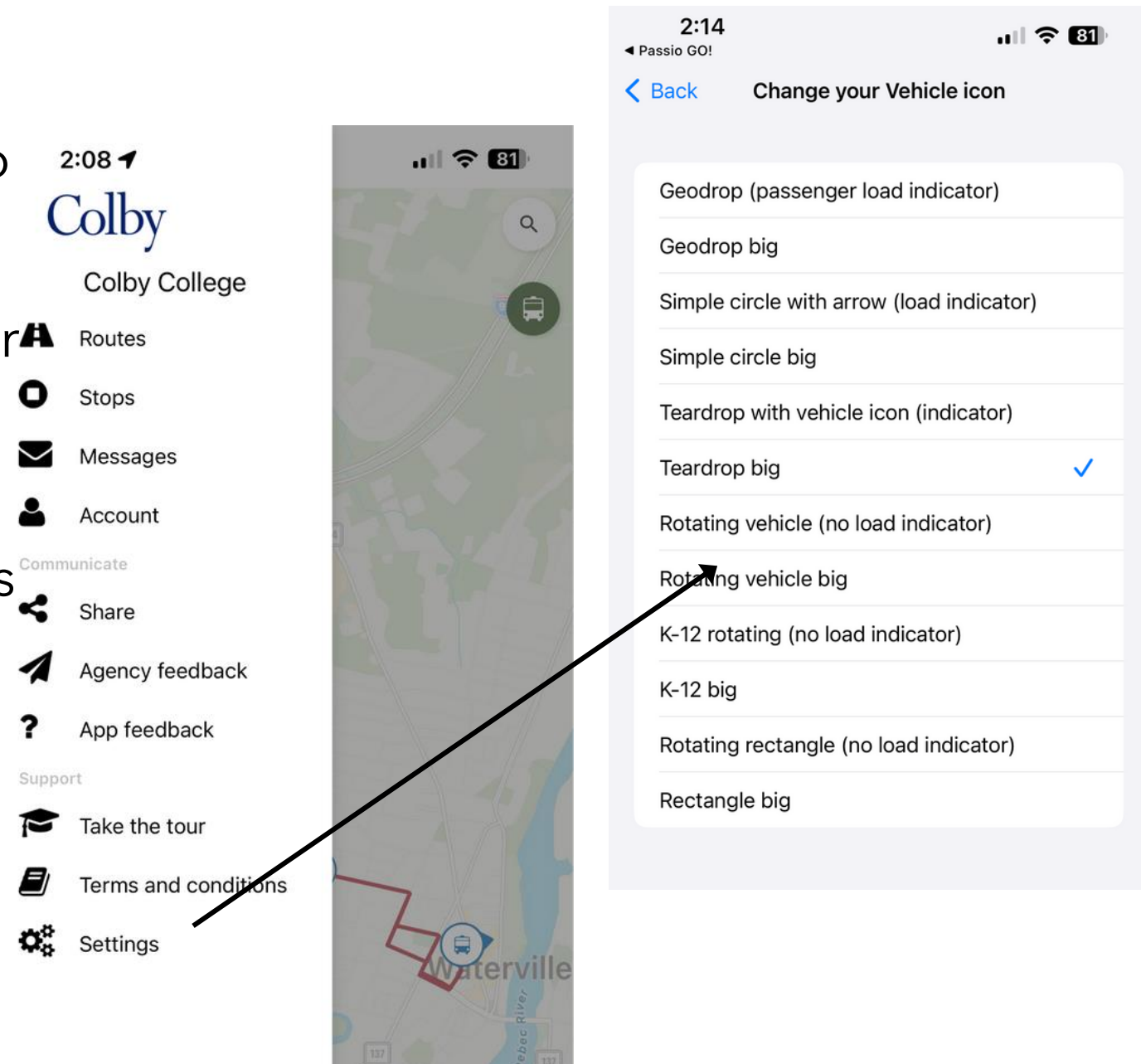
Alerts

- Click "alert" on the route or stop you want to receive alerts for.
- You can select specific or recurring days and time intervals for each alarm.



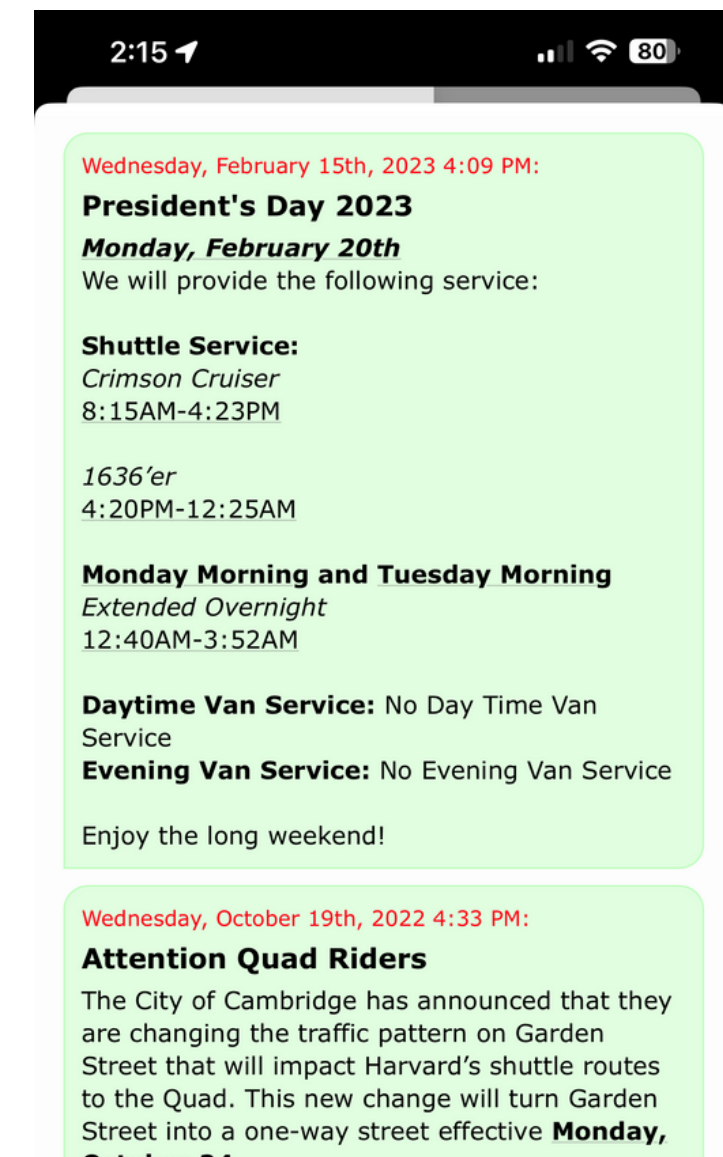
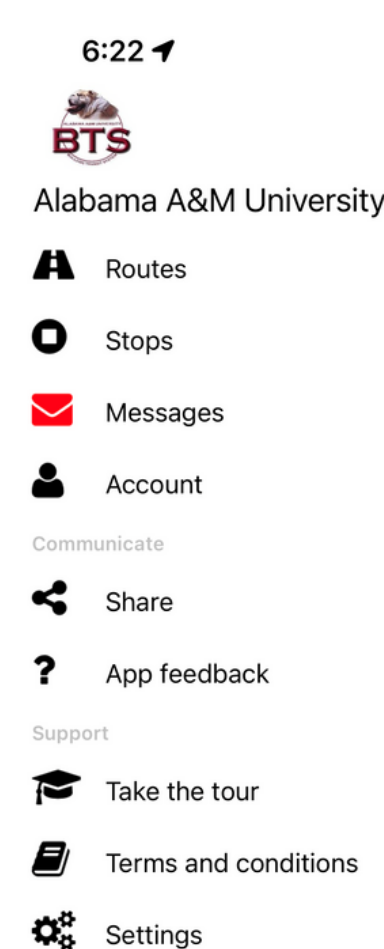
Rider View of Passio GO

- Riders can click on a bus to view the details of the vehicle, like the schedule, route, and ETAs pertaining to the stops within the route.
- App users can even see driver name and the passenger load if the agency has passenger counting abilities.
- The Passio GO Map only shows active routes, making it easier for the passenger to see at a glance what route is running at anytime.
- Riders can change how their bus icon looks in app settings



Passio GO Messages

- Agencies have the ability to send out messages or alerts to riders using the Passio GO app.
- New messages show a red envelope
- Messages can be sent as Important and scroll as a red bar across the map or sent directly to message center



BusBuzz

- Riders can send feedback using Passio BusBuzz via a special text shortcode or within the app.
- Agencies can monitor what their employees write back to riders, and even track response times.

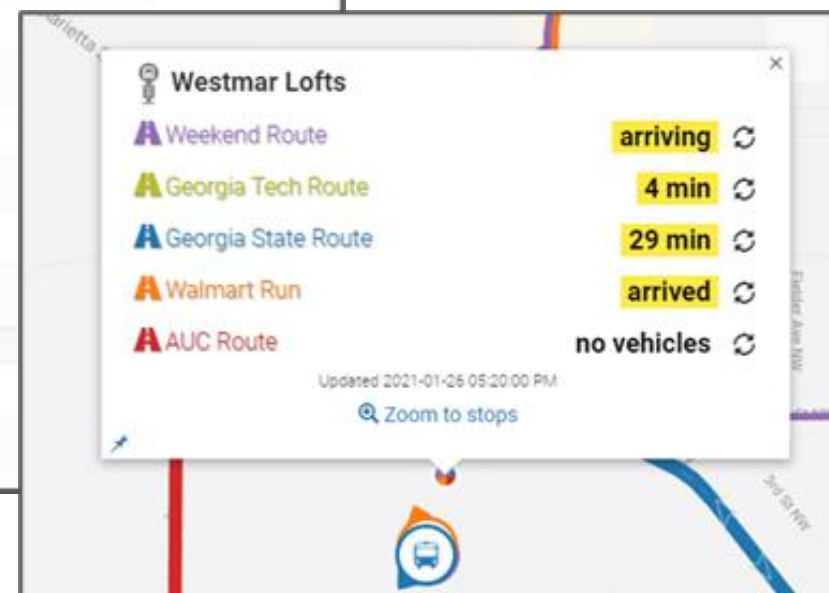
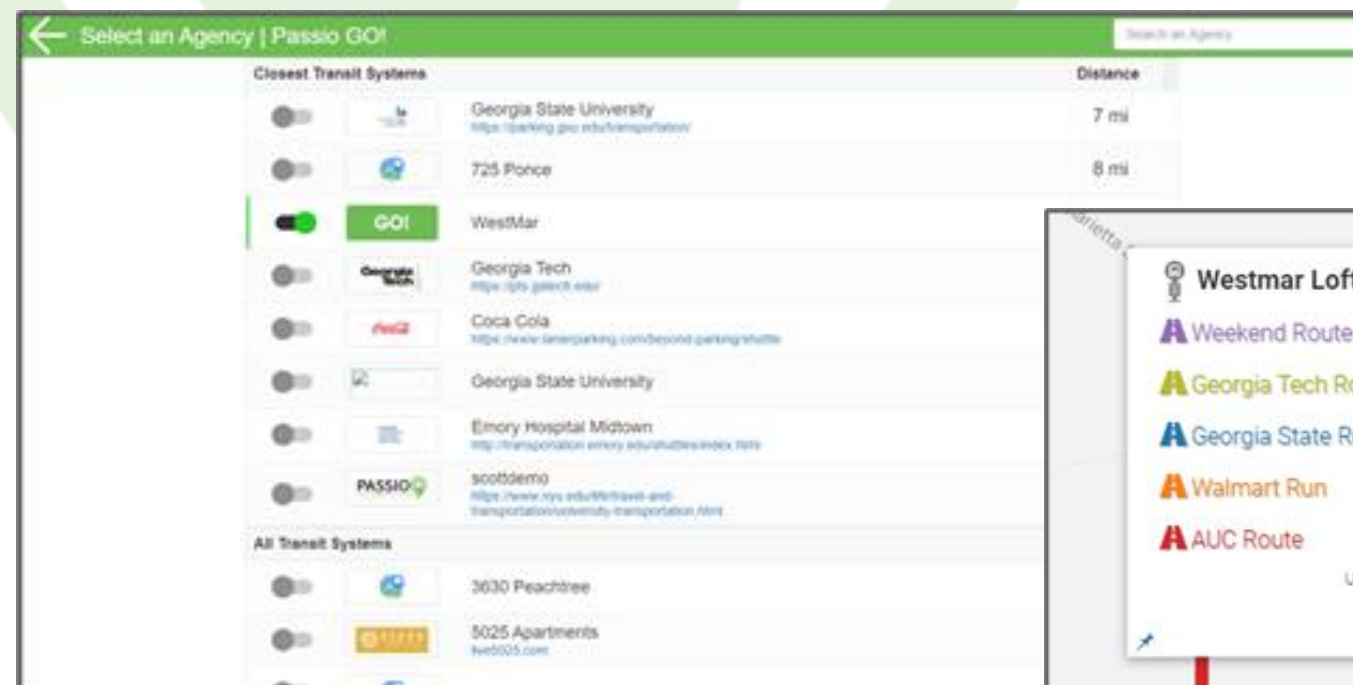
Follow My Bus
