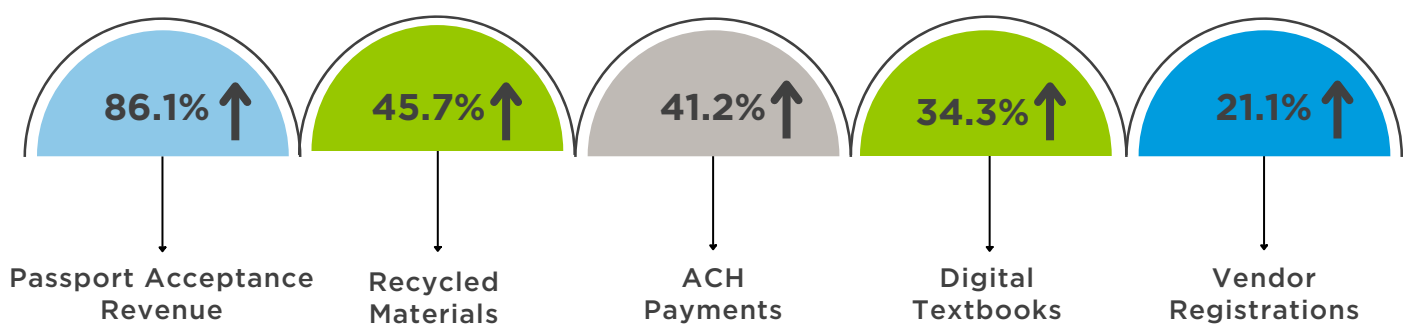

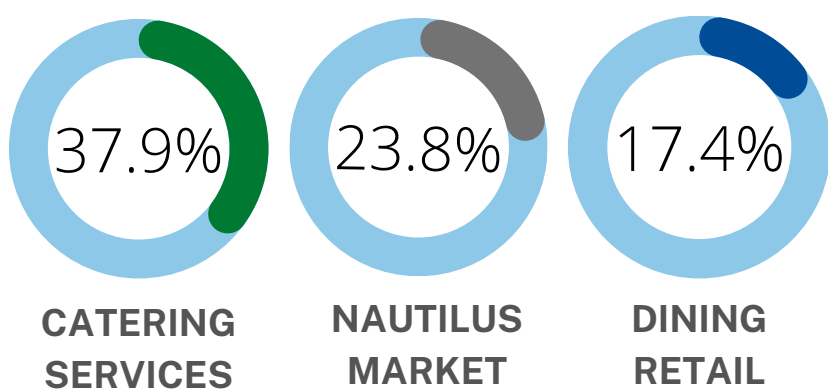


NEW BUSINESS in Argonaut Village

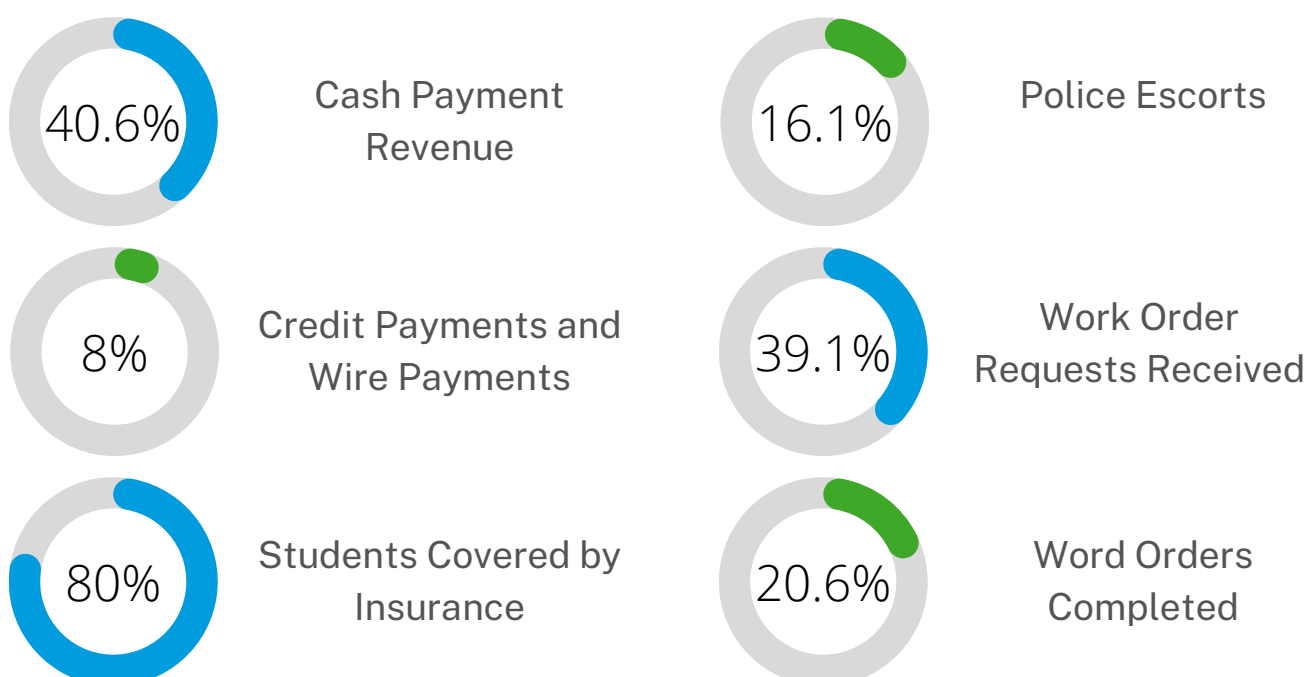
With the opening of this business, Argonaut Village is fully leased.

Controller's, Environmental Health and Safety, Police and Facilities Management saw increases this year



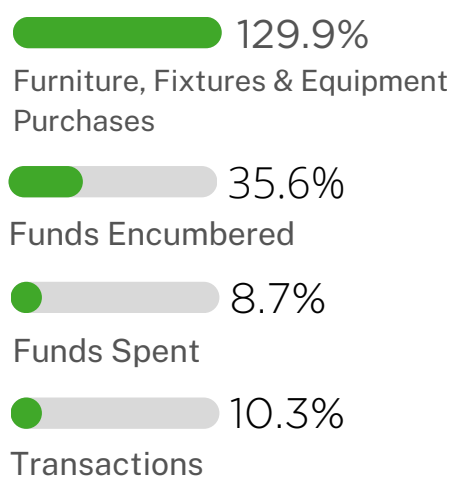
The UWF Police achieved accreditation from the Florida Commission for Law Enforcement.

The UWF Police also achieved the Bronze level in the Lexipol Connect Recognition Program for 2022.

Bronze level performance can be achieved by meeting the minimum required performance for four metrics: Average Hours of Training Assigned, Average Hours of Training Completed, User Activity and External Training Ratio.
